Ocean 10 Studios Opens New Facility to Produce Film, Television and Audio Recording in Myrtle Beach

MYRTLE BEACH (SC) – June 5, 2009 -- The Myrtle Beach Regional Economic Development Corporation joined the South Carolina Film Commission in announcing today that Ocean 10 Studios, Inc. will open a new production facility in Myrtle Beach. The \$2.8 million investment is expected to create 15 new jobs.

“One reason Ocean 10 Studios decided to locate to Myrtle Beach is that Myrtle Beach and Horry County are VERY film friendly,” states Steve Teachout, Ocean 10 Studios president. “The area also offers a wide diversity of locations and resources that are far more budget friendly than many other locales across the US.”

According to Teachout, Ocean 10 Studios’ new facility is a satellite production house for the Baltimore location. Ocean 10 Studios’ 27,000 square foot facility will be used primarily for filming Ocean 10 Studios’ productions. Teachout thinks his film industry expedition to Myrtle Beach will lead others to the Grand Strand as well.

“We’re very excited to have this new business come to Myrtle Beach and to provide our residents with new job opportunities. We realize this type of business will require special talents and training in its workforce but that they will also need administrative support as well,” comments City of Myrtle Beach Mayor John Rhodes. “We believe Ocean 10 Studios and its productions will bring national recognition to Myrtle Beach and all that we have to offer.”

A former commercial airline pilot, Teachout and his colleagues have used Grand Strand Airport in North Myrtle Beach for out of market travel. In comparing Grand Strand Airport to Ft. Lauderdale, Los Angeles, and Baltimore, Teachout touted the North Myrtle Beach airport’s low ramp fees and jet fuel cost as well as enclosed hangers and long runway as selling points for his film industry colleagues who have private planes.
