MBREDc Board of Directors Call for Nominations

The Myrtle Beach Regional Economic Development Corporation is a public-private partnership tasked with the recruitment and retention of high-quality businesses and industries throughout Horry County. The MBREDc Board of Directors is responsible for the overall vision, purpose, and strategic plan for the MBREDc and meets quarterly. Board members serve for a three-year term and are eligible for appointment to the MBREDc Executive Committee after serving one year on the MBREDc Board of Directors. Per the MBREDc Bylaws, MBREDc members in good standing are asked to present any nominations for consideration for Board appointment to the Nominating Committee. Nominees for Board appointment should meet the following criteria:

- **Be willing and able to attend quarterly MBREDc Board meetings;**
- **Represent an organization that financially supports the MBREDc at or above the Executive Partner level (\$1,000 annually);**
- **Be willing to support the MBREDc through attendance at education, social, project announcement events, and committee meetings throughout the year;**
- **Provide proven leadership and previous board and/or management experience;**
- **Provide a diverse Board representation, including age, gender, ethnicity, race, and geography;**
and
- **Provide a skillset beneficial to the MBREDc, including, but not limited to, finance, legal, auditing, marketing, sales, real estate, engineering, construction, community/governmental affairs, healthcare and/or technology.**

MBREDc members can nominate individuals, including themselves, by sending a letter of nomination and a copy of the individual's current resume/bio to Sandy Davis at sdavis@mbredc.org

Nominations will close on **October 15, 2021**.

South Carolina's total non-seasonally adjusted nonfarm employment rose by 2,200 net jobs to 2,140,400 in July, a 0.1 percent increase from revised June numbers and 3.0 percent higher than one year ago. Many sectors reported net job gains for the month, including Leisure and Hospitality (9,400); Manufacturing (3,500); Finance (700); Construction (400); and Other Services (100). Net job losses were reported in the Government (-7,000); Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (-2,500); and Educational and Health Services (-2,400) sectors. Natural Resources and Mining; Information; and Professional and Business Services were unchanged from the prior month. Compared to one year ago, the state economy added 62,400 net nonfarm jobs. Recycling Reporting +

Supporting S.C.'s Green Industry

Recycling is a green growth industry in South Carolina, with the total economic impact of the sector now exceeding \$13 billion. Many of the state's more than 6,000 manufacturers recycle, which helps feed materials into local recycling markets. However, many businesses don't report recycling data.

How can S.C. businesses report? Companies can easily submit recycling data through DHEC's S.C. Smart Business Recycling Program [website](#) or send an [email](#) to request recycling form D-0572.

What's in it for companies? Businesses become members of DHEC's Smart Business program and receive technical assistance and other benefits, including a window cling to display the company's commitment to recycling. After reporting, the organization can apply to be a [Smart Business Award](#) winner and have the opportunity to be featured on the Smart Business webpage and in the program's quarterly newsletter.

Bottom line: When companies recycle and report, the confidential data provides a complete picture of recycling efforts throughout South Carolina. The county where the business resides is credited, elevating the county's recycling success. Every year on March 15, the county and statewide recycling rates are published in the S.C. Solid Waste Management [Annual Report](#). The data helps with trends, planning, local government grants and recycled materials market analysis.

Next steps: In summary, all businesses are encouraged to report recycling activities. It's good for the economy and the environment!

Fast fact: S.C.'s 2020 recycling rate was 25.5%.
