Recognition Given To Hagg is the Highest Civilian Honor Presented to State Citizens

Lieutenant Governor Pamela Evette presented the honor, recognizing Hagg for his 28 years of service to HTC, his contributions to the state, as well as the telecommunications industry and his community service efforts.

In 2022, bFIVE40 expanded into 3D knitting technology to bring custom technical products to the automotive and energy space - this innovative technology creates cost savings through efficiency gains and on-shores jobs to mitigate supply chain risk.

The Outreach Award honors a manufacturer making a tangible and measurable impact on communities in South Carolina. Worksman Cycles of Conway was a finalist of this prestigious award. #### Santee Cooper Board Advances Greener Plan

Natural gas unit offers flexibility, supports planned solar

Advancing its leaner, greener resource plan put forth in 2020, the Santee Cooper Board of Directors discussed plans for a new natural gas unit to partially replace retiring coal units, help integrate more renewable power and meet expected customer load growth.

"Santee Cooper needs additional natural gas generation to provide the flexibility to add more solar power," Staton said. "Solar power is an intermittent resource, and natural gas can be ramped up or down quickly as the sun rises, falls, or hides behind an afternoon thunderstorm, which provides the system reliability we need. The unit we're planning also could be switched to hydrogen fuel when that market matures, which will further decrease our carbon footprint."
