President Trump Lands in Conway

President Donald Trump made a stop in Conway on Wednesday as part of his tour of the Carolinas to see the damage that was caused by Hurricane Florence.

President Trump walked through downtown Conway and around Long Avenue to visit with families in flooded areas with South Carolina Gov. Henry McMaster.

The President then met with local and state officials, South Carolina senators Lindsey Graham and Tim Scott, and Congressman Tom Rice at the Horry County Emergency Operations Center, assuring them that Washington is behind the county and will provide federal assistance.

"We are behind you from day one from three days ago and now it looks nice but it's really the calm before the storm," President Trump said. "You will get a lot of water, we see it, it's coming down. No one would believe something like this could happen. All of that water is coming your way and people don't know that and they assume, you look outside and you see this beautiful weather but over the next couple of days it's going to get rough in South Carolina."

President Trump said there's going to be a rebuilding process and that will start soon.

"We are all with you a hundred percent and we will get through it, I think the most exciting part is the rebuilding, there's a lot, I flew over it, and there's a lot of damage and you haven't really been hit yet compared to what's coming. I love South Carolina I love this state and I love Henry McMaster and the job he's done."

The governor said the cooperation with other federal agencies is the best it's ever been, adding "we are confident we will come out of this."

Trump thanked Henry McMaster and promised the full support of the federal government.

Website Aides in Disaster Re-Entry for SC Businesses

One year after Hurricane Irma formed, a new law is helping businesses get back up and running more quickly after disaster strikes.

The South Carolina Emergency Management Division has a new online tool allowing businesses to pre-register for certification for re-entry. The application is set to streamline the process, allowing business leaders to immediately certify their organizations.

"The fastest way for a community to recover from a disaster is by helping local businesses resume normal operations as quickly as possible. This new tool will do that. It makes the process more efficient for both business leaders and our staff, especially under emergency conditions," Kim Stenson, director of SCEMD said.

Business owners that certified prior to the automated system going online still have a valid memorandum of agreement showing they are in good standing with the State of South Carolina. Companies desiring to maintain re-entry certification at the end of the three year period need simply to go online and re-certify.
